

## Things you need to know when you audition at YTN

Thank you for auditioning for our 2020-2021 School Season. In order for our casting process to run smoothly, and with less confusion, we've outlined the procedures below.

### What happens after I've auditioned?

We will email lists for callbacks no later than 8:00pm on **Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>**. "Callback" is a second round of auditions where you will be auditioning for a specific show.

### When are the callbacks?

If you are called back for a show, it will just be for one of the slots. Callbacks check-in directions will be emailed.

Rescued – Monday September 21<sup>st</sup> 4:00-5:00, 5:15-6:15

Sidekick Island – Saturday September 19<sup>th</sup> from 1:00-2:00, 2:15-3:15, or 3:30-4:30

Radio Drama – (on Zoom) Tuesday September 22<sup>nd</sup> 4:00-5:00 or 5:15-6:15

Complete Works...Shakespeare – Tuesday September 22<sup>nd</sup> 6:30-7:30 or 7:45-8:45

Wizard of Oz, Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> – Monday September 21<sup>st</sup> 5:30-6:30, 6:45-7:45, or 8:00-9:00

Thursday September 24<sup>th</sup> 5:30-6:30, 6:45-7:45, or 8:00-9:00

Wizard of Oz, Young Stages – Thursday September 24<sup>th</sup> 4:00-5:00 or 5:15-6:15

Sky Below Conservatory – (on Zoom) Wednesday September 23<sup>rd</sup> 4:00-5:00 or 5:15-6:15

Check your email and the website for details about your callbacks.

### What do I do if I get a callback?

You do not need to respond to us. Just follow the directions for the show(s) that you are called in comfortable clothing since you might be asked to move. You will be given material from the show at the callback to read so you do not need to prepare anything. **It is very important that you submit your conflict form before the callback.**

### What should I do if I can't make the callback?

There is a section on our audition form that asks if you have a conflict with callback dates. Please make a note there. **Wednesday September 23<sup>rd</sup> 5:00-6:00 on Zoom** is the "catch all" call back day, which means those who can't attend callbacks on other shows, we can see you then. If that does not work, then we are likely to make our decision based on the first audition.

### What should I do if I get a callback for a show I am not interested in doing or unable to do?

If a schedule issue prevents you from doing the show, please contact Cory Southwell at [cory@youththeatre.org](mailto:cory@youththeatre.org) and he will relay the message to the director. However, if you are just unsure about the show, we encourage you to come and find out. You can always decline later. Sometimes, your impression of the show is very different from what the show is and coming to the callback is the best way to find out.

### When and how will I find out about casting?

We will email the final casting on **Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, no later than 8:00pm.**

### What do I do if I get cast in a show?

You will need to email Cory at [cory@youththeatre.org](mailto:cory@youththeatre.org) and say if you accept or decline the offer by the end of **Sunday, September 27<sup>th</sup>**. There will also be further instructions on the website as to registration and payment for the roles/shows you are accepting, so please make sure to check for those as well and follow the directions carefully.

Please be sure to read all the instructions on the callback and casting page on our website. As we are working hard to process over 100 students, we ask that you refrain from calling us to check on the casting status or make requests (other than what we listed above) during this process.
