

Audition Tips for kids grades 1 to 3

- Dress neatly and be ready to move around
- Take a deep breath before you start-it helps to calm you down, it is OK to be nervous-everyone is
- Listen carefully to the instruction of the educator
- If you are asked to speak, speak loudly and clearly
- Have a positive attitude and do your best
- Don't worry if you make a mistake-audition is not a test
- Be ready while you play the game
- If the educator asks for a volunteer, be brave and volunteer
- When you act things out, do it big and all the way
- Don't try to be a character from the play you are auditioning for-just do what the educator is asking you to do
- Don't look at the directors when you act things out-look above their heads or each other, depending on the game you are playing
- Ask questions if you don't understand something
- Be kind to other kids in your group and polite to all the grown ups you come in contact with
- Above all, be your self, and HAVE FUN!!
