Things you need to know when you audition at YTN

Thank you for auditioning for our 2021-2022 School Season. In order for our casting process to run smoothly, and with less confusion, we've outlined the procedures below.

What happens after I've auditioned today?

We will post a callback list on our website (www.youththeatre.org) no later than 3:00pm on **Saturday, September 11th**. When the list is live, you will receive an email notification from us, but if for some reason the technology fails and our email doesn't reach you in time, it will be very easy to find it on our website. "Callback" is a second round of auditions where you will be auditioning for a specific show. If you are called back, only your audition number (**not** your name) will be on the list so please remember your number.

All callbacks will meet at and be dismissed from the front of Parish Hall Theatre at Emmanuel Church.

What do I do if I get a callback?

You do not need to respond to us. Just come on the day that you are called in comfortable clothing since you might be asked to move or dance. You will be given material from the show at the callback to read and sing (if it is a musical) so you do not need to prepare anything. Please be ready to stay the whole time unless it's indicated otherwise on the website. **It is very important that you fill out your online conflict sheet before your callback.**

What should I do if I can't make the callback?

There is a section on our audition form that asks if you have a conflict with callback dates. Please make a note there. **Monday, September 13th from 6:30-9:00** is the "catch all" call back day, which means those who can't attend callbacks on other shows, we can see you then. If that does not work, then we are likely to make our decision based on the first audition.

What should I do if I get a callback for a show I am not interested in doing or unable to do?

If a schedule issue prevents you from doing the show, please contact Cory Southwell at cory@youththeatre.org and he will relay the message to the director. However, if you are just unsure about the show, we encourage you to come and find out. You can always decline later. Sometimes, your impression of the show is very different from what the show is and coming to the callback is the best way to find out.

When and how will I find out about casting?

We will post the final casting on **Friday, September 17th, no later than 8:00pm**. Again, you will receive an email from us when it goes live.

What do I do if I get cast in a show?

When you check the cast list, you will need to click the button which will take you to a form where you have the option of "accept" or "decline." There will also be further instructions on the website as to registration and payment for the roles/shows you are accepting, so please make sure to check for those as well and follow the directions carefully. You have until **Saturday, September 18th** to complete this form. If there is a special circumstance in which you would need more time, please contact Cory Southwell at cory@youththeatre.org.

As we are working hard to process over 100 students, we ask that you refrain from calling us to check on the casting status or make requests (other than what we listed above) during this process. Thank you for auditioning and break a leg!
